Harvey W. Wemett died very suddenly on New Year's Day in Hemlock, where he had gone on business.

Mr. Wemett was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Mitchell Wemett and was born in Canadice January 8, 1851. Later the family moved to Hemlock, and fifty-two years ago, Mr. Wemett, was married to Ida M. Trimmer of that village. Thirty years ago, he moved to Livonia, where he has resided since.

At the time of his death he was constable of the town of Livonia, superintendent of highways, and deputy sheriff, having filled the last-named office for the past forty-four years.
